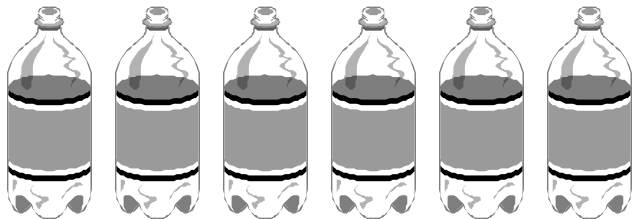
2009 Club Dive Trip
